Our public transport is the way to get to know the city and to visit all its attractions. Whether it is day or night, we aim to get you to your destination in Amsterdam by means of our 15 tram lines, 50 bus lines, 4 metro lines and 5 ferry crossings.

GVB Tickets & Info

When you want to get information in person about Amsterdam's public transport, you are more than welcome to visit GVB Tickets & Info. This is the place to come for travel tickets and passes, maps of Amsterdam's public transport network and timetables for GVB lines all over Amsterdam. To the best attractions

On pages 18-21 you will find a list of the most entertaining and unusual attractions together with details of how to reach them by public transport.

Day and night

Trams, buses and the metro operate from six o'clock in the morning until half-past midnight. Our night buses operate from half-past midnight until around seven o'clock in the morning. See also page 14-15.

A special night rate applies to the night bus. However, your GVB one-day pass or a GVB multi-day pass will also be accepted. Ask for the free Night Buses folder at GVB Tickets & Info.

Affordable Day Passes

Amsterdam's public transport system uses the OV-chipkaart. This is a card that you load with money so that it works like an electronic purse. We offer various types. If you are staying just a couple of days in Amsterdam, your most useful and cheapest option is the one-day or multi-day pass. This gives you unlimited travel on all trams, buses and metros operated by GVB throughout Amsterdam, without having to consider transfer times.

For a day out in Amsterdam, we have the one-day pass. This is valid for 24 hours from the first time you check in. Within the 24-hour period of validity, you can hop between GVB modes of transport, checking in and out of buses, trams and metros, as often as you like. If you plan to stay longer, we have other passes that are valid from 2 to 7 days (48 to 168 hours validity).

How do I travel with the OV-chipkaart?

Tram and bus Every time you enter and leave a vehicle you need to check in or check out. When your trip includes a change of vehicle, you have to check out of the first vehicle and into the next one. To check in, you hold your pass in front of the card reader. Readers are

placed at the entrances and exits of all trams and buses. When you check in, you will hear one beep and see a green light. When you check out as you leave a tram or bus, you will hear two beeps.

Metro When you arrive at a metro station, hold your pass in front of the card reader that is built into the metro gate. The gate will open. You check out in the same way at the station where you exit the metro system.

Where can I buy the OV-chipkaart?

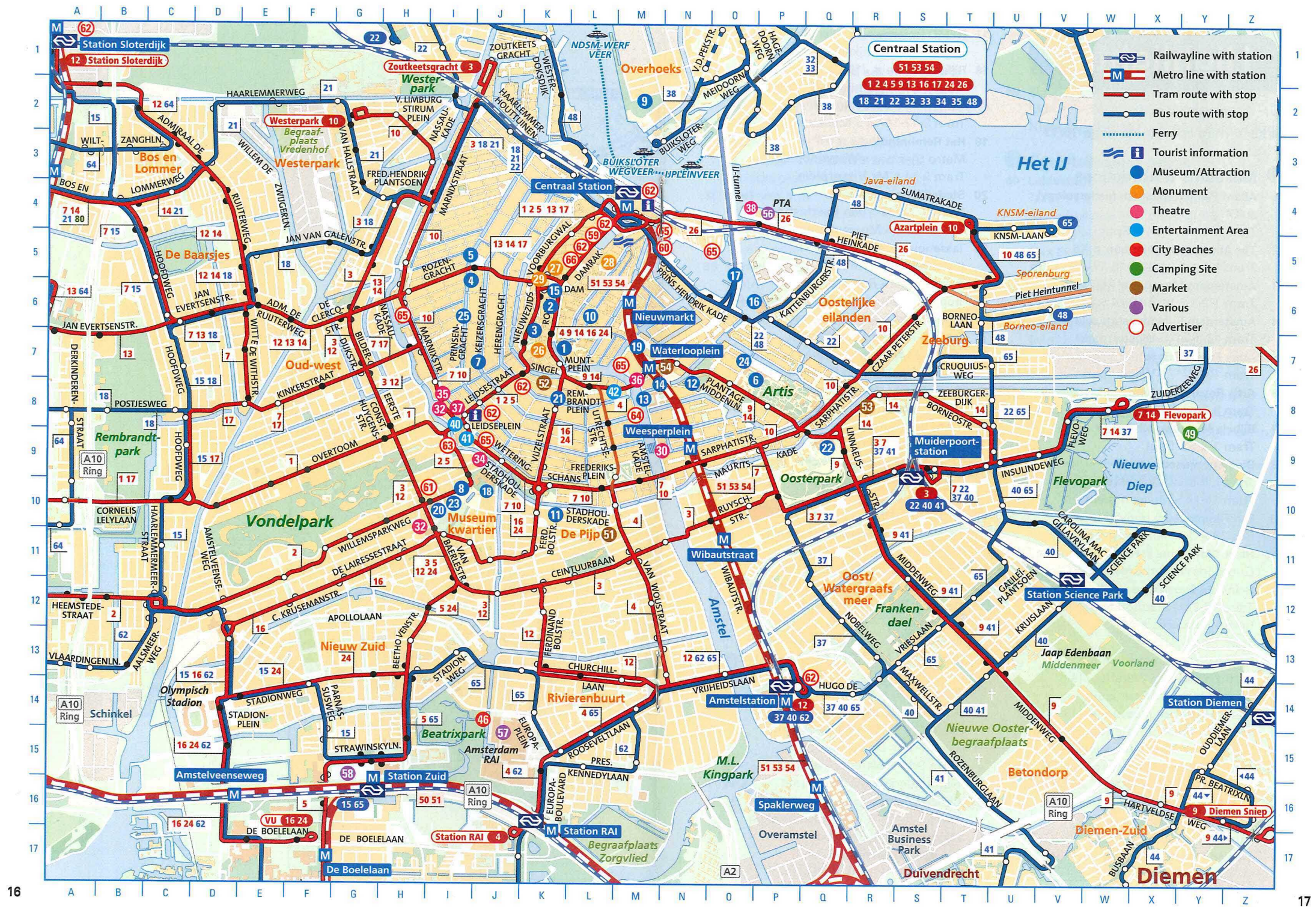
OV-chipkaarts are available at GVB Tickets & Info. You can also buy the GVB one-day pass from the driver or conductor in the tram or bus. When you buy a ticket from

the driver or conductor, please have the right money ready. Both one-day and multi-day passes are also sold at vending machines at all metro stations.

Entry door tram

To help you enter and exit quickly and easily, Amsterdam's trams have designated entry and exit doors. The entry door is the double door at the back of the tram. Alternatively, you can enter at the door next to the driver. The exit doors all have swing gates. See page 26.
